More than a doctrine, the Trinity expresses the heart of our faith: we have experienced the God of creation made known in Jesus Christ and with us always through the Holy Spirit. We celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity in word and sacrament, as we profess the creed, and as we are sent into the world to bear witness to our faith.



Scripture Thoughts

We can hear more clearly the words Matthew relayed to first believers: “Remember, I am with you all days until the end of the time of the world” (literally translated). No matter what else, these are words that soothe, comfort, and engage. Two things about them: first, coupled with Genesis 1, these last words of the gospel span beginning to end of time as we know it—with no breaks; second, Jesus is the one who places himself as the span, being present to the church, bearing the authority of God. To the eleven, desperately trying to figure out next steps, these words came as pure, welcomed promise, albeit without much clarity. They were just beginning to figure out that they too were resurrected, peppered with recollections of things learned in Jesus’ school. How, exactly, would Jesus be “with” them and us?

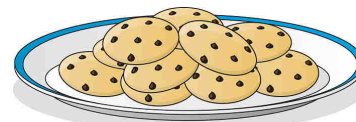
